- Earn a stipend of \$2,000 for 8 weeks of research (25 h per week) with a member of BCCC-CURE

  - Your application must include the following:
    - This completed application form including the contact information
    - Your Research Summary

    - Your Short CV, including grades
    - A recommendation letter from a science high school teacher.
